- The Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation (MTDC) had organised a three day exhibition called "MAHARASHTRA INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL MART" (MITM) from 28/9/2015 to 30/9/2015 at the Bombay Convention & Exhibition Centre, NESCO Complex, Goregaon East, Mumbai on the eve of the 'World Tourism Day' celebrated on 27/9/2015.
- MITM is an endeavour to bring in the maximum number of tourism buyers and sellers on a single platform and empower them to explore economic growth opportunities in Maharashtra's tourism sector.

- The Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State enthusiastically participated in this exhibition and effectively showcased the potential of Ayurved Panchakarma treatment and other AYUSH systems of Medicine in the promoting Healthcare & Wellness within the society and in boosting the State Healthcare & Wellness Tourism.
- The AYUSH Stall was thoughtfully designed by the Directorate of AYUSH so as to attract the attention of the domestic and international tourism buyers and traders. It consisted of the following components-
 - Live demonstrations of Ayurvedic therapeutic procedures like Full Body Medicated Oil Massage(Sarvanga Abhyanga), Head Massage (Shiro Abhyanga) and Foot Massage (Pada Abhyanga) performed by trained therapists and masseurs.
 - Detailed medical consultation by expert Ayurvedic physicians.
 - An informative exhibition of 25-30 live species of commonly used medicinal plants of Ayurved and a pictorial banner depicting some of the common ailments like constipation, hyperacidity, hypertension and insomnia etc and the important medicinal plants and Ayurvedic formulation used in their management.
 - A pictorial banner depicting the indications and benefits of selective Ayurvedic therapeutic procedures like Shirodhara, Shirobasti, Nasya, Sarvanga Taila Dhara, Netratarpan, Udvartan etc.
 - A brochure containing informative knowledge about Ayurved and Panchakarma treatments and other AYUSH systems of

- Medicine along with the details of the State AYUSH regulatory framework was distributed amongst all the delegates visiting the Stall.
- Live demonstration of Yoga was performed by Yoga experts for creating general awareness about Yoga and its health benefits.
- The exhibition was inaugurated by Shri Devendra Fadnavis, Hon'ble Chief minister, Government of Maharashtra. Other eminent dignitaries present during the inauguration were Prof. Ram Shinde, Minister of State for Tourism, Home (rural), Public Health and Marketing; Shri.
